All products are processed under strict hygienic conditions and in compliance with local institutions for standardization like the Tanzania Plant Health and Pesticides Authority{TPHPA} and international standardization like food safety regulations such as HACCP{Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Points} and ISO 22000. We conduct routine quality checks from farm to packaging to ensure traceability, consistency, and premium quality.

These products are transported to our central processing facility where they undergo value-added processes before being packaged and dispatched to global destinations.

Processing & Packaging Facility

At our facility, products go through the following processing stages:

- Sorting & Grading
- Cleaning & Washing

- Drying (machinery-dried, oven-dried, or dehydrated depending on the product)
- Cutting & Slicing (for selected fruits, vegetables, and spices)
- Quality Inspection & Weighing

Eco-Friendly Packaging

Our packaging materials are biodegradable and eco-conscious designed to preserve freshness while minimizing environmental impact. All dried and preserved products are packed in food-grade, compostable bags suitable for international shipping.

Export Strategy & Market Focus

Approximately 95% of our products are exported overseas, with key markets in:

- ✧ Europe
- ✧ Regional Markets within East and Southern Africa

Our export team ensures proper documentation, compliance with international phytosanitary , regulations, and timely shipping logistics through the port of Dar es Salaam.

The remaining 5% of products and by-products are directed toward animal feed production. Peels, broken grains, seed husks, and other natural residues are repurposed into nutritious feed blends for livestock, promoting zero-waste operations and contributing to sustainable agricultural practices.
